Proof of Funds

How to prove them?

Through an official PDF bank statement in your exclusive name (less than 30 days old). Sponsors or joint accounts are not accepted. It must be stamped, signed, and translated.

Can I extend my WHV?

You cannot extend the visa, the maximum limit is exactly 12 months. To perform a change of immigration status, you must first leave the country and re-enter.

Additional Documents



Medical Exams

Good news: No medical certificate or clinical analysis of any kind is required for your application to Denmark.



Criminal Records

They are not physically required. This document is replaced by the Sworn Declaration integrated into the WH1 form.



Language & Translation

Knowing the language is not mandatory. However, all official documents must be certified translated into English or Danish.



Medical Insurance & Studies

Key Points

- **Mandatory insurance:** Minimum coverage of €30,000 for your entire stay (includes hospitalization and repatriation).
- **Recommendation:** For Australia and Canada it is not strictly required due to healthcare agreements, but it is highly recommended.
- **Education:** Studying is allowed as a secondary activity (short courses of 3 to 6 months duration).

Calendar and Opening Dates

Latin America

For citizens of **Argentina and Chile**, quotas are divided into two annual periods. The official calendar openings are **March 1st** and **September 1st**.

Attention! Appointments run out in a matter of hours.

Rest of the World

For **Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Japan, and South Korea**, the calendar is **open all year round**. There are no specific opening dates or quota limits, allowing you to apply freely at any time.

Application Types

Hybrid Application

Applicable to Oceania and Asia. The WH1/2 form is submitted online, fees are paid digitally, and only biometrics are taken at a local VFS center.

In-person Application

Exclusive to Latin America (Chile and Argentina). Requires a physically printed WH1 form signed by hand, printed receipts, and submission of all documentation in person at VFS.

Official Application Checklist

- ✓ Official WH1 or WH1/2 form (completed online or printed depending on the country).
- ✓ Payment receipts (SIRI Fee and/or Consular Fee).
- ✓ Color copy of all passport pages (cover to cover).
- ✓ Proof of Financial Solvency (Approx. €2,700 to €3,900 in own account).
- ✓ Medical Insurance Policy translated and with a repatriation clause.


