Complete guide to requirements and application

Universal Requirements

Key rules that apply to all nationalities for the Norwegian WHV.

Vital Financial Support

It is crucial to demonstrate sufficient funds equivalent to living expenses for the first 3 months of stay. In addition to this amount, you must possess a return ticket to your home country, or alternatively, the additional money necessary to purchase one.

Age and Education Requirements

Age Range

The general eligibility requires being between **18 and 30 years old (inclusive)** at the time of submitting the official application.

Exceptionally, citizens of Canada enjoy an extended limit, allowing them to apply up to 35 years of age.

Education and Language

Unlike other visas, Norway **does not require proving** any minimum educational level or professional title to apply.

Nor is it mandatory to take prior language exams, although possessing conversational English or Norwegian will facilitate your insertion.

Proof of Funds

- The applicant must have liquid funds equivalent to **NOK 45,507**.
- This amount is calculated to cover maintenance exclusively for the first 3 months.
- It must be demonstrated through an **official bank statement** in the holder's name.
- Alternatively, it can be supported by presenting a prior **official job offer** in Norwegian territory.



Translations and Legality

Official Documentation

All documents issued in your native language must be mandatorily translated into English or Norwegian by a certified official public translator.

Additionally, to have international legal validity, the original documents must be duly legalized through the **Hague Apostille**.



Health and Medical Insurance



Comprehensive Mandatory Coverage

It is an essential requirement to present a private medical insurance policy. This must ensure total **hospitalization coverage** throughout the entire duration of the visa. Unlike other destinations, Norway exempts applicants from undergoing tuberculosis tests (with specific exceptions such as Japan, which requires a simple medical certificate).

Visa Conditions



Work

The visa allows you to work legally full-time during the 12 months of your stay, facilitating the full financing of your trip through the country.



Studies

Educational activity is secondary. You will be able to study, but it will be limited to a strict maximum of 3 months, ideal for short courses or immersion in the Norwegian language.



Extensions

For most, the permit is valid for 12 months and is legally non-renewable. Only Australians and Canadians have treaties that allow for renewals.

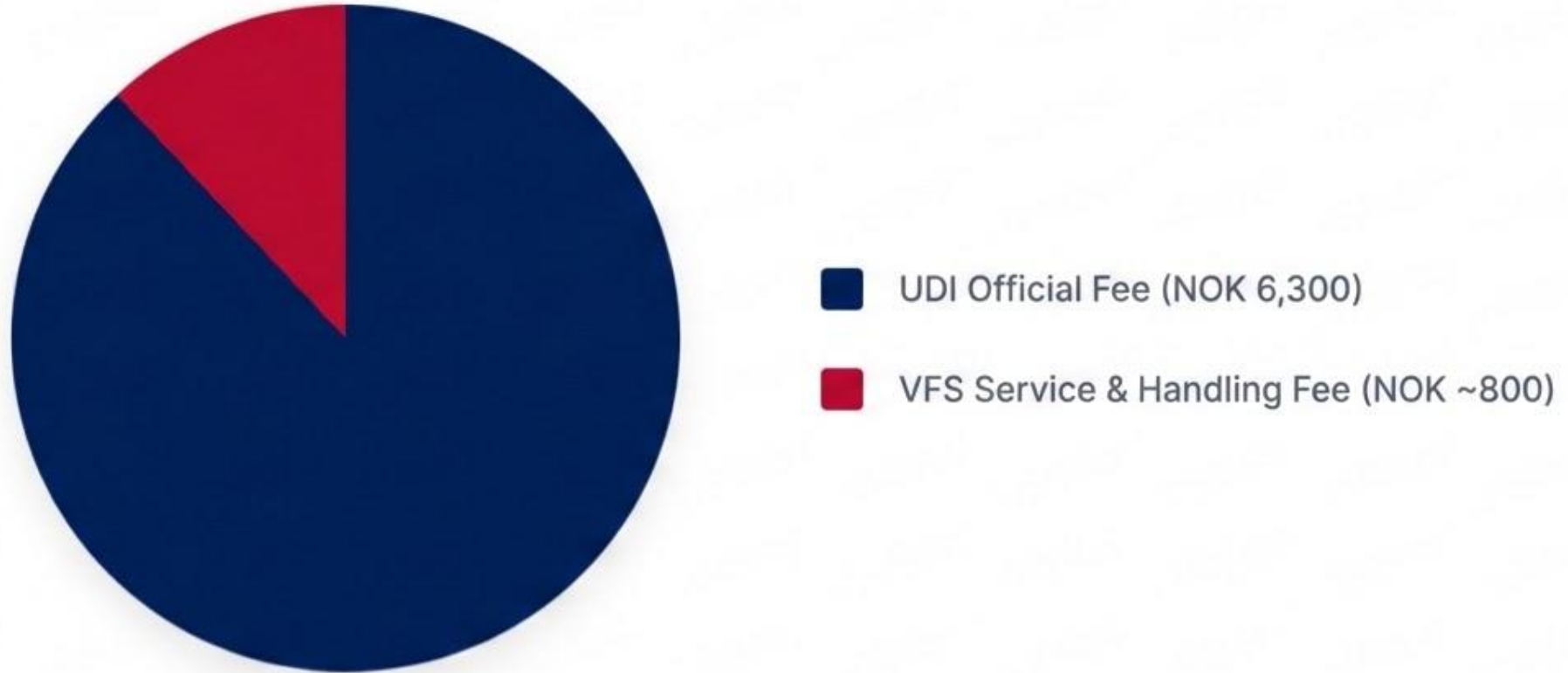
Country Specifications

Quotas, operational processes, and specific details according to your nationality.

Nationality Comparison

Nationality	Age Range	Annual Quotas	Application Type
Argentina	18 to 30 years	300 (High competition)	In-person (From country of origin)
Canada	18 to 35 years	125 quotas	In-person (From country of origin)
Australia / N. Zealand	18 to 30 years	Unlimited	Flexible (Does not require origin)
Japan / Andorra	18 to 30 years	Unlimited	In-person (From country of origin)

Visa Cost Breakdown



88% of the operational costs correspond to the processing fee required by the Directorate of Immigration (UDI). Please note that translation and apostille expenses are additional variables not reflected here.

Application Process

Step 2: Dossier

Gather bank statements, medical insurance, and manage translations with corresponding apostilles.

Step 4: Travel

Await official resolution. It is strictly forbidden to travel to Norway without approval.






Step 1: Online

Register on the official UDI portal, create an account, and pay the NOK 6,300 fee.

Step 3: Biometrics

In-person appointment at the VFS Global center or Embassy to submit documents and biometrics.

Official Checklist

-  **Valid Passport:** Must have a minimum validity of 3 months beyond the planned departure date, including copies of used pages.
-  **Cover Letter:** Official signed document downloaded directly from the UDI portal after payment.
-  **Financial Support:** Reliable proof of liquid funds of NOK 45,507, presented via bank statement in your name.
-  **Medical Insurance:** Sworn declaration or active policy guaranteeing comprehensive medical and hospital coverage for the entire stay.
-  **Extra Forms:** Two recent passport photos and the personalized official Checklist provided by the migration authorities.
