# Fundamental Requirements

Basic criteria that international applicants must meet to obtain the visa in the Argentine Republic.

# Eligibility Criteria

## Age Range

The program is aimed at young people. Depending on the specific bilateral agreement with the country of origin, the allowed age range at the time of application is 18 to 30 years (or up to 35 years in certain cases).

## Individual Travel

The application is strictly personal. Applicants cannot travel accompanied by dependent family members (spouses or children) under this same visa category.

# Financial and Travel Requirements



## Proof of Funds

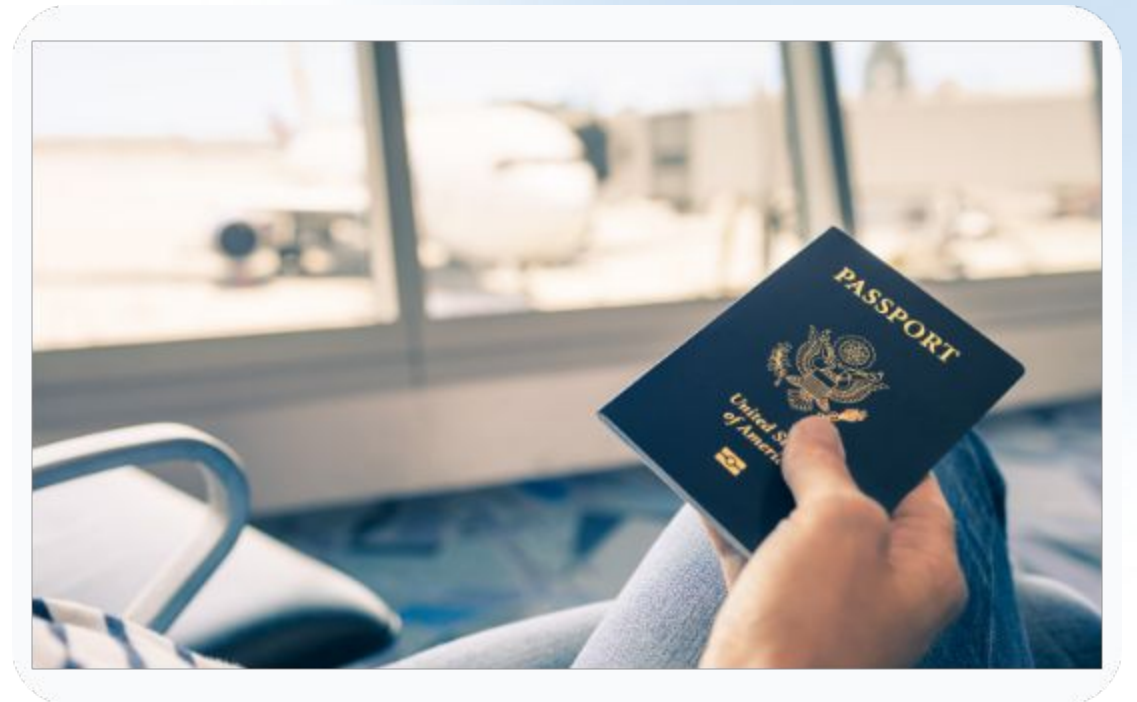
It is necessary to prove sufficient funds to cover the initial living expenses during the first months of stay in Argentina (the amount varies according to each consulate's disposition).

## Mention of the Return Ticket

It is mandatory to have a return ticket to your country of origin, or failing that, formally demonstrate sufficient additional funds to purchase said ticket at the end of the stay.

# Required Legal Documentation

-  **Criminal Record:** Certificate of absence of criminal record from the country of origin for the last 3 years, duly apostilled.
-  **Sworn Statement:** Signed form where the applicant declares to lack a criminal record internationally.
-  **Medical Insurance:** Comprehensive policy for 12 months covering hospitalization and health/repatriation expenses.



# Countries with Active Agreements

Argentina maintains bilateral relations with multiple nations for the exchange of young professionals and travelers.

# Interpretation of Agreement Statuses

When consulting the official list of the Argentine Foreign Ministry, it is important to understand the current status of each bilateral agreement. Use this reference:



## Yellow Color

Corresponds to 'En Pausa: Indefinida o con fecha de reanudacion' (On Pause: Indefinite or with resumption date). It indicates that the agreement legally exists, but temporarily no new visas are being issued for that nationality.



## White Color

Means 'Sin convenio' (No agreement). It clearly indicates that there is currently no legal Working Holiday visa framework agreed between Argentina and the consulted country.

# Work and Employment

## Purpose of the Trip


The main and demonstrable objective of the program must be to vacation in Argentina.


Employment is considered a secondary and temporary activity to help cover travel and living expenses.


## Labor Limits

Generally, it is not allowed to work for the same employer for more than six (6) months. The visa is not designed to obtain permanent employment or to settle permanently.

# Academic Development





 **Permitted Studies:** Although the visa is not a student visa, it does allow short-term training activities.

 **Academic Offer:** You can take advantage of Argentina's extensive and renowned academic offer to enroll in improvement or language courses.

 **Time Limit:** Training or study courses cannot exceed three (3) to six (6) months in total, depending on the agreement.



# Application Process

-  **Argentine Consulate:** The process must strictly begin at the Argentine Consulate corresponding to your place of residence or origin.
-  **Document Translation:** All documentation in a foreign language (such as criminal records) must be translated into Spanish by a recognized public translator.
-  **Consular Interview:** A mandatory face-to-face interview with the consular authority will be required to finalize the evaluation of your application.
-  **Prior Approval:** The visa will be stamped in the passport before the trip. It is strictly forbidden to process it or change your tourist status to Working Holiday while already in Argentina.

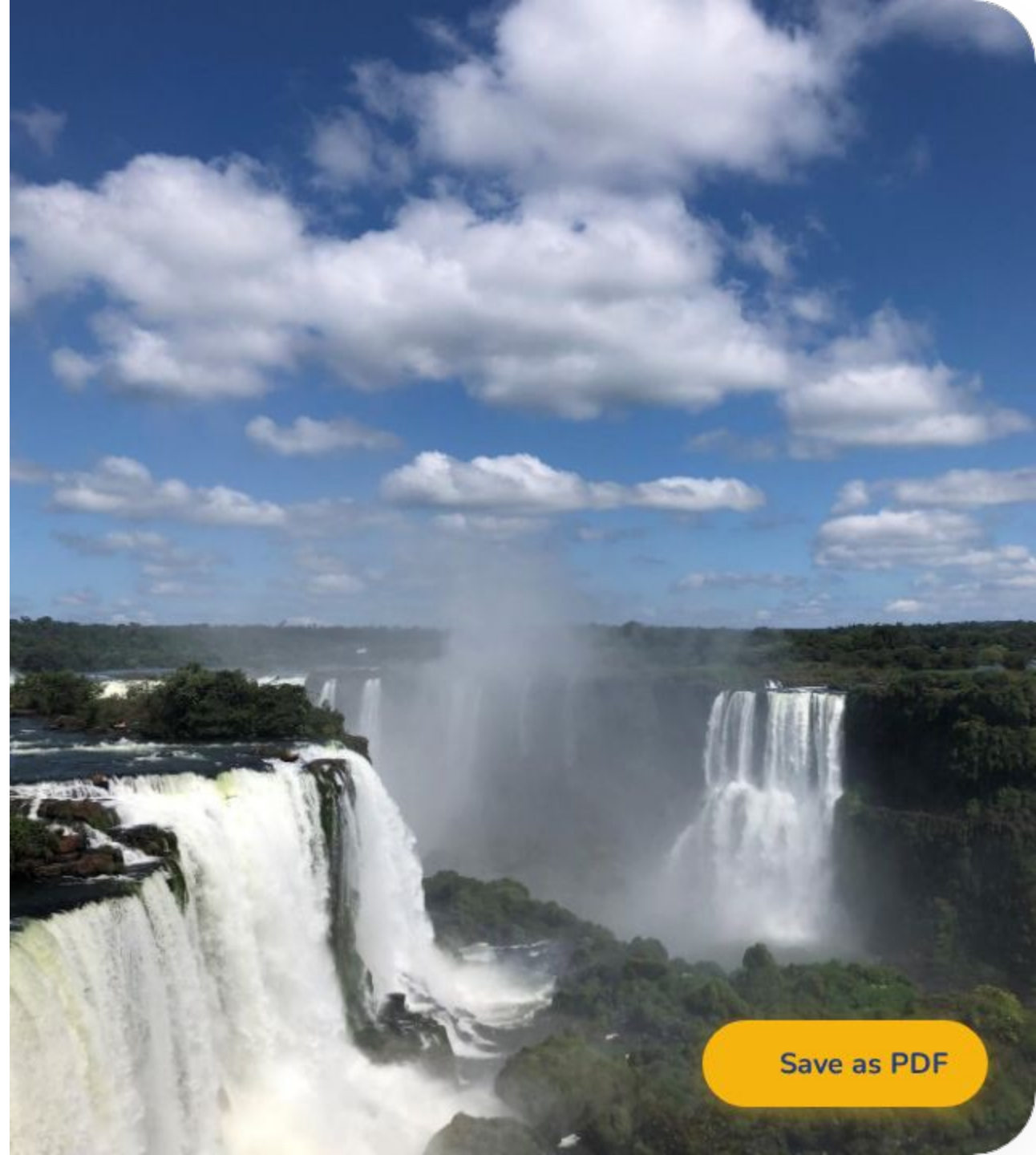

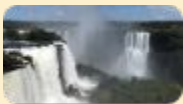
