Universal Requirements

Key rules and general criteria that apply to all nationalities
to access the Working Holiday program.

General Criteria (Visa 417 & 462)



Age Range

Strictly between 18 to 30 years old (inclusive) for most countries. Only nationalities like France or Italy extend up to 35 years old.



Base Funds

Proof of economic capacity of \$5,000 AUD for initial support is required, plus an outbound ticket from the country (or sufficient funds to buy it).



Visa Cost

The standard consular fee is \$670 AUD. Small additional surcharges for using credit card or PayPal payment should be considered.

Proof of Funds

Official Bank Statement

To prove your financial support, Immigration is strict about the format of the required documentation:

- It must be an official 'Bank Statement' issued by your bank.
- The document must be exclusively in your name (joint accounts without your name or sponsors are not accepted).
- It must be recent (generally less than 30 days old at the time of application).
- If the document is not in English, it requires an official external translation (unless the bank issues it bilingually).



WHV Extension and Regional Work

Can I extend my stay?

Yes, your initial 12-month visa can be extended for 1 or 2 more years. Unlike other countries (like Denmark where the maximum is 1 year), Australia encourages extension through the 'Regional Work' program.

Extension Requirements

To qualify for a second or third year, you must undertake specified work in regional areas of Australia. Approved industries vary by subclass, but typically include: farm work, construction, mining, or tourism/hospitality (in the North of the country).

Functional English Requirement

Applicants for the Subclass 462 Visa (most Latin American countries and Spain) must demonstrate a 'Functional' level of English. This is accredited by achieving the minimum required score on valid international exams such as IELTS, TOEFL, PTE, or CAE, taken within the last 12 months. Subclass 417 countries or native English speakers are exempt from this step.

Medical Exams and Insurance



Health Exams

High-risk countries (TB) must undergo mandatory exams (X-rays and check-up).

If your country is low-risk, routine exams are not required, unless you work in health-related fields.



Medical Insurance

It is not mandatory for applying, but it is highly essential for traveling, as most do not have RHCA Medicare coverage (except for a few bilateral agreements).



Criminal Records

Unlike other visas, this process is done "On Demand". You only need to present your police certificates if Immigration formally requests it during the assessment.

Allowed Studies in Australia



Continuous Education and Short Courses

The Working Holiday Visa legally authorizes you to study, but as a secondary activity. It is permitted to take training, language, or specialization courses for a maximum of **4 months (17 weeks)**.

regarding educational evidence to apply for the visa:
Applicants for visa 462 generally need to demonstrate at least 2 years of university studies or tertiary degree (or High School in cases like USA or Chile), while the 417 does not demand prior study requirements.

Quotas and Application Calendar

Unlimited Quotas (Visa 417 / Certain 462)

Nationalities such as Germany, France, Italy or the USA have no vacancy restrictions. Application is possible at any time of the year and quotas never run out, facilitating a process without pressure from cutoff dates.

Limited Quotas (Visa 462 - Latam/Europe)

For countries like Argentina, Chile, Spain or Peru, applications open annually on July 1st (start of the Australian fiscal year). Quotas (e.g. 3,400 or 1,500) usually last from a few hours to a few months, operating under rapid demand.

Approval Times and Type of Processing

Differentiated Assessment Systems

The time it takes to receive your approved visa will depend fundamentally on your nationality and the subclass you apply for, due to the review methods of the Department of Immigration.

Automated Process (Visa 417)


For citizens of the European Union and other 417 countries, the system is highly automated. Often, approval arrives within hours or a few days after payment.


Manual Verification (Visa 462)


Applicants for the 462 undergo a more exhaustive manual review of documents (translations, bank statements, medical or English exams). The estimated time is usually around 2 to 6 weeks.




Official Application Checklist

 **Identity and Passport:** High-quality color copy of the biographical data page of your valid passport. Ideally, it should be valid for your entire planned stay in Australia.

 **Financial Proof:** Official bank statement demonstrating the equivalent of \$5,000 AUD, plus possessing your return ticket or sufficient extra funds to purchase it in the future.

 **English Exam (462 Only):** Official certificate with valid results (IELTS, TOEFL, PTE or CAE) that accredits your functional level of the language.

 **Academic Evidence (462 Only):** Transcript or diploma proving that you meet the minimum required educational level (university, tertiary or secondary, depending on your country).

 **Letter of Support (If applicable to your country):** Document issued by the government of your country of origin approving your application (Required only for specific nationalities like Peru, Ecuador or Slovenia).

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



Traveling with Someone?

The WHV is a strictly individual visa. You cannot include dependents or children in your application. If you are traveling as a couple, each person must obtain their own approved visa.



Dual Nationality?

If you hold two eligible passports, it is always advisable to apply with the one that offers better advantages: Subclass 417 or the one with unlimited quotas.



What if the quotas run out?

If your country has a visa limit and the system indicates the cap has been reached, you will have to wait for the next opening of the Australian fiscal year every July 1st.
